

# How to manage videos on Blackboard - Student

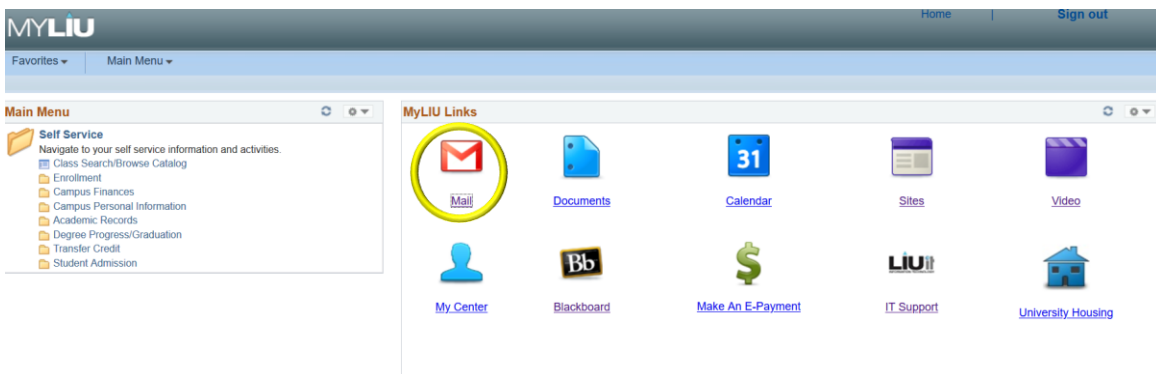
Your instructors may require you record and upload video content for your courses. However, Blackboard is **NOT** equipped to upload large video files

If you have video files to share with your instructors, we recommend you do the following:

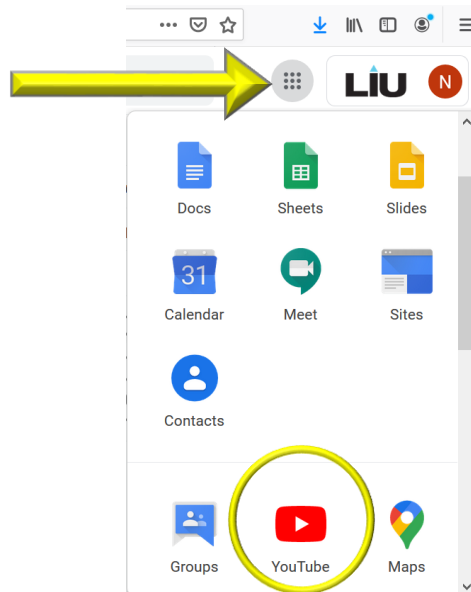
## 1. Uploading to YouTube

Step 1: Login to [my.liu.edu](http://my.liu.edu)

Step 2: Select “Mail”



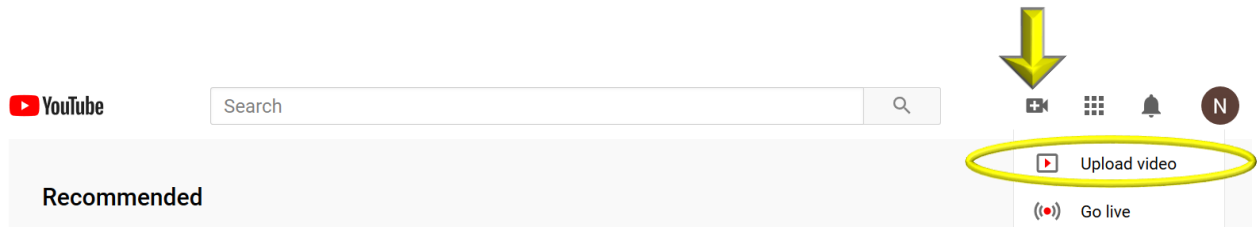
Step 3: Select YouTube from your Google Apps Menu.



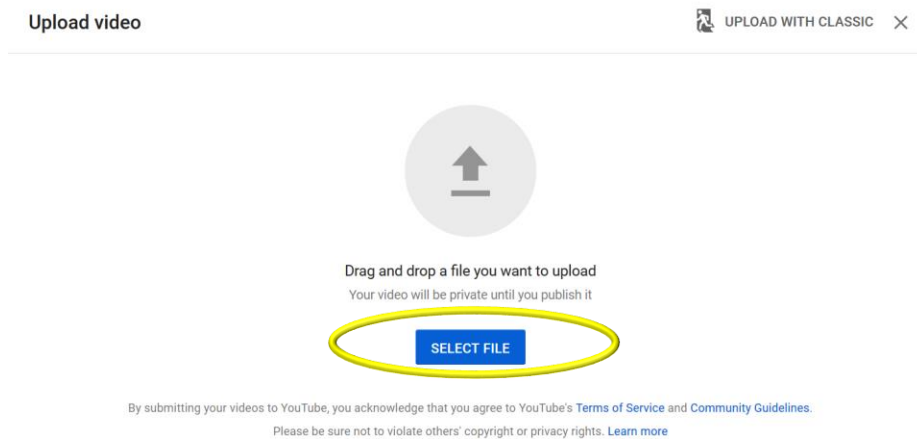
Step 4: Sign in to YouTube.



Step 5: At the top right, select Create a video or post  > Upload video.

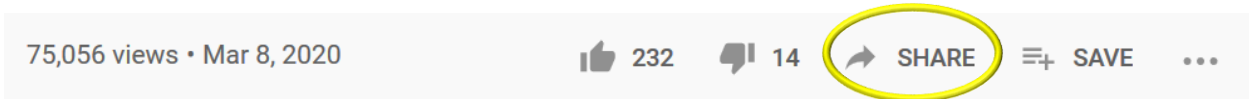


## Step 6: Select the file you'd like to upload.

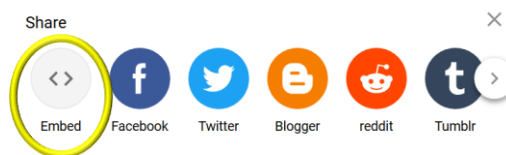

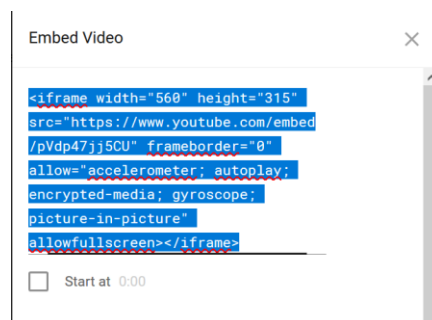
## Step 7: Under the video, click SHARE ↗.



## Step 8: Click Embed.



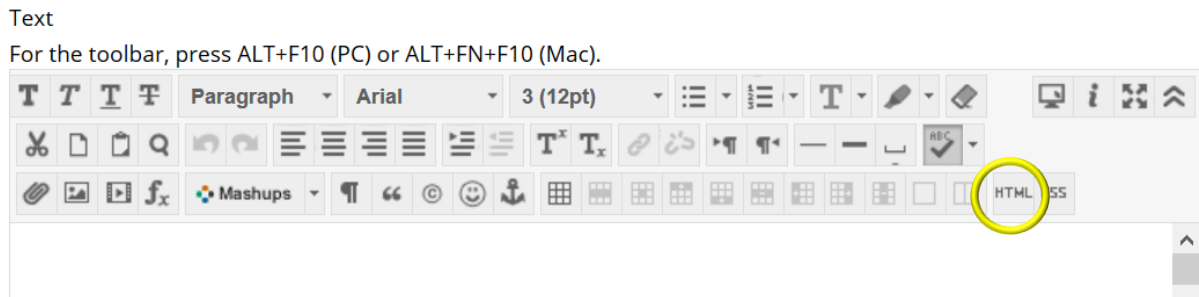
## Step 9: From the box that appears, copy the HTML code.



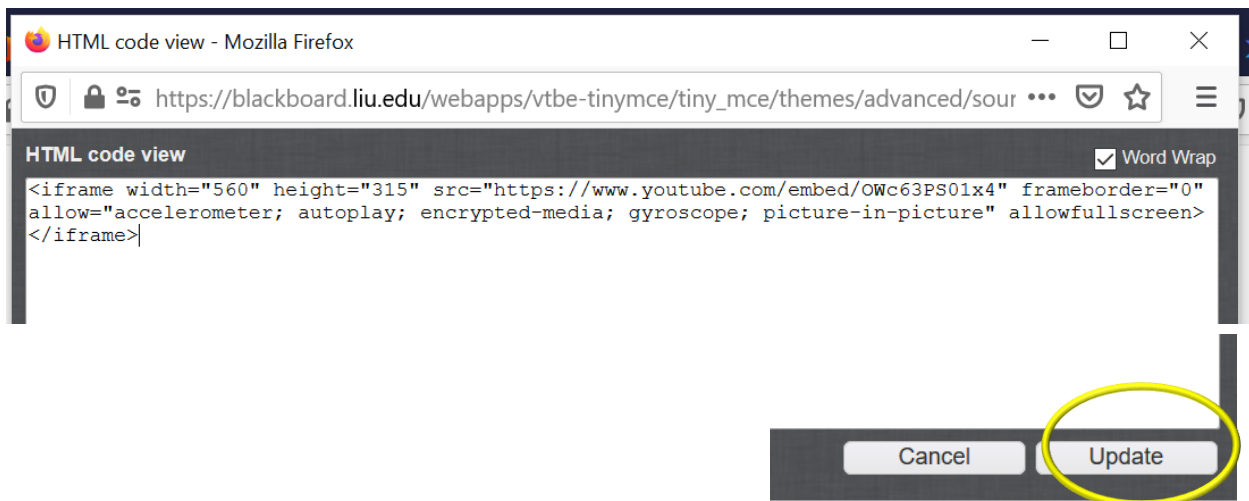

**Step 10: In Blackboard, navigate to the section your instructor would like you to submit.**  
Note: This could be an assignment, discussion board, etc.

**Step 11: Choose the HTML code button in the Text editor**



**Step 12: Paste in the entire EMBED code from the YouTube website. Then Select “update”**



**Step 13: Select “Submit”**
